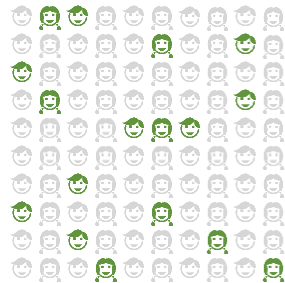


Children, Youth, and Young Adults in Israel: Selected Risk Indicators
